

Driving Directions

From the North

Due to the collapse of the 35W bridge, our directions from the North have been modified. Following will be the quickest route.

Take 35W South to the 4th Street exit (Exit #18). Turn right (West) onto 4th Street and travel to Central Avenue. Take a left (South) onto Central Avenue/MN 65 and take this bridge across the river to Washington Avenue. Turn right on Washington Avenue and travel to Marquette Avenue. Turn right on Marquette and travel ½ block to 2nd street. Turn right on 2nd street (which looks almost like an alley). Parking is provided in this lot behind the building on 2nd street.

From the East:

Take I-94 West to the Cedar Avenue exit (exit number 234C). Turn right onto Cedar Avenue (CR-152 N). Bear left onto Washington Avenue and continue for 1 ½ miles. Turn right (North) onto Marquette. Turn right again onto 2nd street. Parking is provided at the back of the building in the lot off of 2nd street.

From the South:

Travel North on interstate 35W. At the 35W and MN-65 (Downtown Exits) split, stay in the left lane and take the MN-65 Downtown Exits. Remain on 5th Avenue South as the interstate ends. Take 5th Avenue South to Washington Avenue South. Turn left (West) onto Washington Avenue South. Turn right (North) onto Marquette. Turn right again onto 2nd street. Parking is provided at the back of the building in the lot off of 2nd street.

From the West:

Take 394 East to the Washington Avenue exit (exit number 9C). Turn right on Washington Avenue. Turn left onto Marquette. Turn right onto 2nd street. Parking is provided at the back of the building in the lot off of 2nd street.

Additional Options from the Airport – Light Rail Transit:

Take any northbound train towards downtown Minneapolis. Exit the train at the Nicollet Mall station. You will need to walk one block east to Marquette Avenue. Turn left on Marquette Avenue (North) and walk three blocks to Washington Avenue. Our office is located at 100 Washington Avenue South.

Train fare is \$1.75 during peak times (Monday through Friday, except holidays). Peak times are 6-9 a.m. and 3 – 6:30 p.m. Train fare during off-peak times is \$1.25. No fare is required between the Lindbergh and Humphrey Terminal stations.

Trains run approximately every seven minutes during rush hours and less frequently during non-rush hours. From the Mall of America, it takes about half an hour to reach the Nicollet Mall station and slightly less time from the airport.
